1. Tour Route Planning

- **DAY 1:**
Depart + Nanjing Road + The Bund + Oriental Pearl Tower +
Chenghuang Temple
- **DAY 2:**
Madame Tussauds Shanghai + Sinan Road + City Sightseeing Bus
- **DAY 3:**
Fudan University + Return

2. Service Content

2.1 Fees Included:

- **Transportation:** Round-trip shuttle buses between the airport/railway station and the destination, as well as shuttle buses between scenic areas.
- **Hotel:** Accommodation fees are included.
- **Catering:** Not included, recommended only
- **Tickets:** The fee for the first entrance tickets of the scenic spots.
- **Guide:** Full-course explanation service by an English tour guide.

2.2 Fees Not Included:

- Personal expenses incurred during the itinerary (including non-free catering fees on transportation means, excess baggage fees, laundry, telephone, and charges for beverages and alcoholic drinks during the accommodation period, personal medical expenses for illness or injury, etc.), as well as self-paid items not included in the itinerary.

2.3 Self-paid Expenses:

- Night cruise on the Huangpu River by boat, CNY 180 per person.

3.1 DAY 1: Depart + Nanjing Road + The Bund + Oriental Pearl Tower + Chenghuang Temple

- **Transportation:** Train (Beijing - Shanghai)

For trains arriving before 14:00, unified ticket purchase (ticket included)

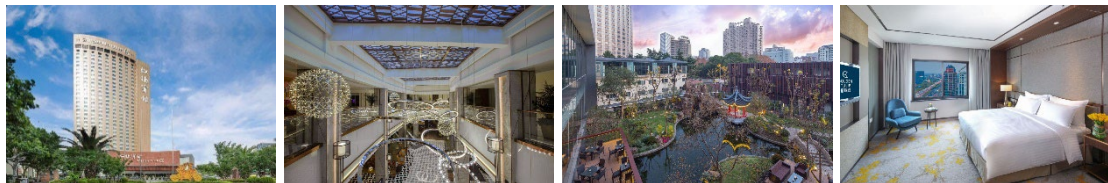
- **Station Pick-up Service**

Upon arrival, the guide will meet you at the station and take the bus to the hotel to check in

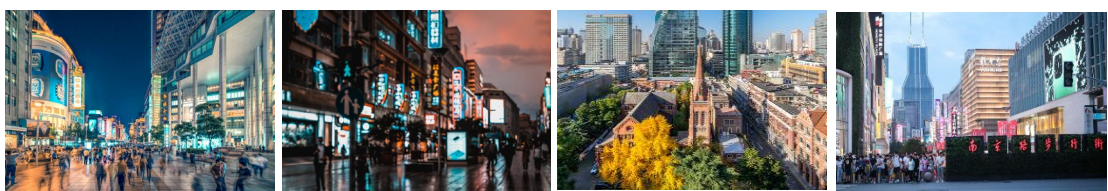
- **Check in**

- **Attraction [Nanjing Road] (Admission is free)**



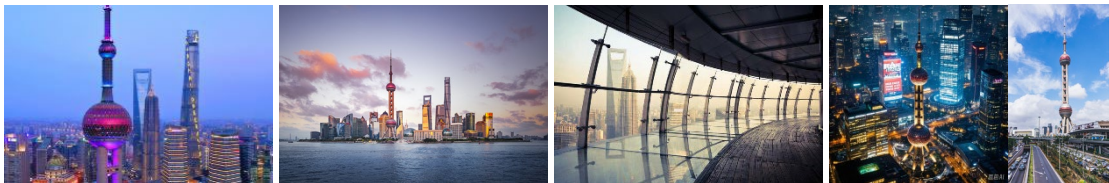
Nanjing Road Pedestrian Street was once a concession of foreign powers and enjoyed the reputation of "the first commercial street in China". It is about 1200 meters long, with shops on both sides, modern buildings and old European buildings scattered. Night falls and the neon lights glow. Take the retro "dang car", shuttle between, you can enjoy the architecture of the world, but also feel the old Shanghai style.

- Attraction [The Bund] (Admission is free)



The Bund is a symbol of Shanghai. Standing beside the Huangpu River, it is about 1.5 kilometers long. The diverse architectural complex of various countries, such as the Bank of China Building and the Peace Hotel, fully showcases the past look of the "Wall Street of the Far East". When night falls and the neon lights are shining, taking a cruise on the river, with the gentle river breeze caressing, the Bund and Lujiazui set each other off, presenting the prosperity of this magic city to the fullest.

- Attraction [The Oriental Pearl Radio & Television Tower] (Tickets included)



The Oriental Pearl Radio & Television Tower is a landmark of Shanghai. Standing in Lujiazui, Pudong, it faces the Bund across the river. It is 468 meters high, with 11 spheres ingeniously connected to form a unique shape.

Once inside, you can have rich experiences. You can climb to the observation deck of the main sphere to enjoy the views of both sides of the Huangpu River, or walk on the 259-meter fully transparent corridor to overlook the whole city, feeling like walking in the air. Here, there are diverse experiences, such as the exhibition hall at the base, the thrilling high-altitude VR roller coaster, and the revolving restaurant, showing the charm of Shanghai.

- Attraction [Chenghuang Temple] (Admission is free)



The Chenghuang Temple Tourist Area is located in the eastern part of the old urban area of Huangpu District, Shanghai, and it is a must-visit place for tourists who are visiting Shanghai for the first time. There are scenic spots such as Yu Garden and the Old Chenghuang Temple here, allowing people to experience the folk customs of Shanghai. There is a great variety of delicious food, like Nanxiang Steamed Buns. At night, the complex of ancient-style buildings is brightly lit, and the commercial area is bustling. Tourists can fully enjoy the pleasures of dining and shopping and indulge themselves in this wonderful place.

3.2 DAY 2: Madame Tussauds Shanghai + Sinan Road + City Sightseeing Bus

- Attraction [Madame Tussauds Shanghai] (Tickets included)



As the sixth Madame Tussauds wax museum in the world, the first one on the Chinese mainland, and the flagship museum in Asia, Madame Tussauds Shanghai has become a popular must-visit destination since it settled in Shanghai New World City in May 2006.

The museum covers an area of approximately 9,000 square meters and has several themed exhibition areas, covering fields such as film and television, music, sports, and science. With nearly 100 wax figures that are lifelike in detail, the museum also has interactive segments like singing duets on the Starlight Stage, allowing visitors to have "intimate conversations" with their idols while appreciating the exhibits and experiencing the charm of wax figure art from all aspects.

- Attraction [Sinan Road] (Admission is free)



Sinan Road, an old street full of historical charm, is a microcosm of Shanghai's urban culture. Located in Huangpu District, it was initially built in 1914 and was originally named Rue Massenet, in memory of the French musician Jules Massenet. On both sides of the street, plane trees introduced from France cast thick shades, and historical buildings stand in great numbers. It is praised as the "living storybook of urban history".

As one of the 11 historical and cultural scenic areas in Shanghai, Sinan Road has preserved clusters of garden villas dating back to before the 1930s. The architectural styles are diverse, including French, Spanish, and British styles, etc., showcasing the essence of Shanghai's modern residential architecture. Classic buildings such as Sinan Mansions, Zhou Enlai's Former Residence, Sinan Bookstore, and Mei Lanfang's Former Residence not only carry rich historical and cultural stories but also have become popular check-in places for tourists to trace the footprints of celebrities.

- Attraction [City Sightseeing Bus] (Tickets included)



In this fast-paced metropolis, you need to slow down and enjoy the beautiful scenery. As the coach slowly passes through the busy streets, whether it's the dazzling night view or the vibrant daytime scene, during the journey to the iconic scenic spots, this bright yellow color will bring you abundant new vitality.

- Attraction [Huangpu River cruise] (Self-paid)



Take a leisurely cruise on the Huangpu River and admire the Bund's complex of buildings from various countries on both sides of the river, which exudes a unique European charm, as well as the architectural complex in Pudong that radiates a strong modern atmosphere.

(The fee is 180 yuan per person and should be borne by oneself; This optional activity is participated in following the principle that guests participate in it voluntarily at their own expense, and there is no forced consumption.)

3.3 DAY 3: Fudan University + Return

- Attraction [Fudan University] (Tickets included)



The Handan Campus of Fudan University is the main campus of Fudan University. It was initially established in 1922 and has a profound historical heritage. The campus covers an area of approximately 922,000 square meters. Iconic buildings such as Guanghai Building and Xianghui Hall are located here. Among them, the Guanghai Building, standing at a height of 142 meters, is the tallest university skyscraper in Asia and carries the long history and cultural traditions of Fudan University.

On the campus, historical buildings and modern landscapes complement each other, creating a strong academic atmosphere. As a comprehensive research university, it has attracted countless tourists to come and experience the charm of this century-old institution of higher learning.
