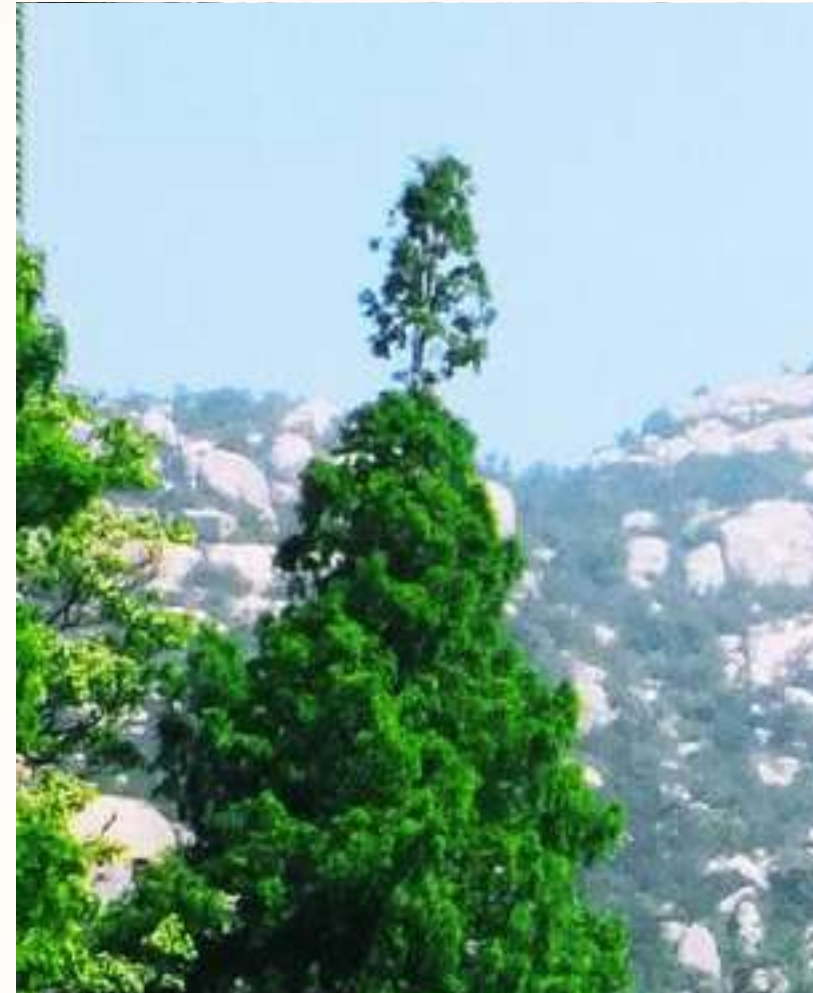

Laoshan Taiqing Scenic Area

- ◆ **Address:** Taiqing Scenic Area, Laoshan District, Qingdao City
- ◆ **Attraction Level:** 5 A
- ◆ **Tour duration:** 3-4 hours

Laoshan, located in the eastern part of Qingdao City, was historically known as Laoshan, Laoshan, and Aoshan. It is the main mountain range of the Shandong Peninsula.

The Taiqing Palace, located in Mount Lao, is the oldest and largest Taoist temple with a history spanning over 2,100 years. This sacred architectural complex includes three most revered religious buildings in the scenic area - the Three Officials Hall, the Three Pure Ones Hall, and the Three Emperors Hall - as well as ancient and famous trees such as the Han Cypress, Tang Elm, and Red Pine. The palace also features legendary Taoist landmarks, including the Wall-Penetrating Screen, Snow-Treading Bridge, and Pu Songling's Library. Visitors flock here to explore ancient mysteries, seek spiritual enlightenment, and experience cultural heritage that has thrived through the ages.

- ◆ **Tour Features:** European charm memories of red-tiled and yellow-walled buildings.

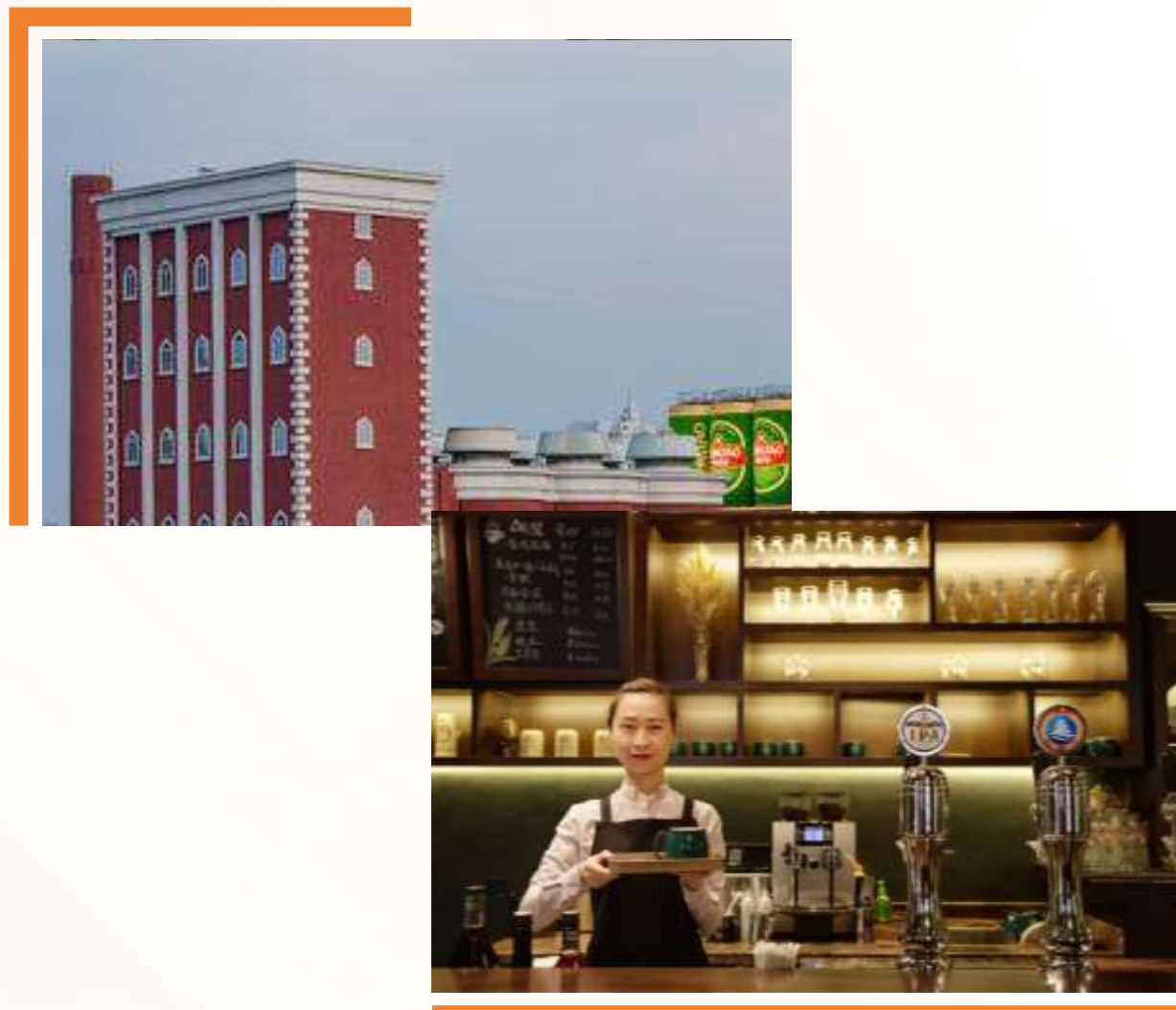
"Site of German Governor's Palace" refers to the location of the former official residence and administrative office of the German colonial governor in Qingdao, China. This historic site is situated at No. 11 Yishui Road, Shinan District, Qingdao, and was constructed between 1902 and 1906. It served various governmental roles through different periods of Qingdao's history and is now recognized as a key cultural relic protected at the national level in China.



Qingdao Beer Museum

- ◆ **Address:** No. 56 Dengzhou Road, Qingdao City
- ◆ **Attraction Level:** 4 A
- ◆ **Tour duration:** 1-2 hours

Qingdao Beer Museum is China's first beer museum, opened in 2003 during the brewery's centenary celebration. Built around the original century-old factory buildings and equipment, the museum showcases the 100-year development of Tsingtao Beer and the Chinese beer industry through rich historical materials. It integrates culture, brewing technology, entertainment, shopping, and dining. In 2006, it was designated as a Key National Protected Unit of Cultural Relics, attracting numerous visitors interested in beer heritage.

Badaguan Scenic Area

- ◆ **Address:**No. 10 Wushengguan Branch Road, Shinan District, Qingdao City
- ◆ **Attraction Level:** 4 A
- ◆ **Tour duration:** 1-3 hours

Badaguan, is a famous scenic and convalescent area. Covering about 666,000 square meters, it was built in the 1930s. The area is named after eight streets styled after ancient Chinese passes. Badaguan features a blend of park and courtyard, with lush trees and blooming flowers. The roads are lined with various tree species, creating beautiful landscapes throughout the year. Its architecture is diverse, showcasing styles from over 20 countries like Russia, Britain, and France, earning it the nickname "World Architecture Museum". In 2001, it became a national cultural relic protection unit. In 2005, it was titled "Most Beautiful Urban Area in China".



May Fourth Square

- ◆ **Address:** No. Donghai West Road, Qingdao City
- ◆ **Attraction Level:** 2 A
- ◆ **Tour duration:** 1-2 hours

May Fourth Square is located in Shinan District, Qingdao, facing the sea. It was built in 1996 and named after the May Fourth Movement. The square covers an area of 100,000 square meters and is divided into two zones by Donghai Road. The north zone mainly features lawns and a central fountain. The south zone includes an open-air stage, dot matrix fountain, and the famous sculpture "May Wind", which symbolizes the patriotism of the May Fourth Movement. The sculpture is about 30 meters high and made of red steel. The square is not only a landmark of Qingdao but also an important base for patriotic education. It's a perfect place for visitors to enjoy the beautiful sea view and feel the city's culture.



Qingdao International Sailing Center

- ◆ **Address:** No. 6 Jinwan Road, Qingdao City
- ◆ **Attraction Level:** 5 A
- ◆ **Tour duration:** 1-2 hours

May Fourth Square, located in Qingdao, covers an area of 10 hectares, stretching 700 meters from north to south. Backed by the Municipal Government building and facing Fushan Bay, it is a modern urban square featuring lawns, fountains, and sculptures. The iconic "May Wind" sculpture, 30 meters high and made of steel, symbolizes the patriotic spirit of the 1919 May Fourth Movement. With its vibrant atmosphere and historical significance, the square has become a landmark of Qingdao. It also hosted the Olympic sailing events in 2008, showcasing its blend of culture, history, and natural beauty.
