

Poster Session Guidelines

If your abstract has been selected for a poster presentation, please carefully review the following guidelines to ensure a successful e-poster presentation!



Poster Display:

- O Your e-poster will be featured electronically in the Exhibition Hall of the Tianfu International Convention Center. The dedicated Poster Area will have 10 e-Poster boards available for viewing.
- O To locate your e-poster, you can search by entering the abstract ID or name.
- O The e-posters will be accessible for viewing throughout the conference, from September 15th to September 17th. Attendees can visit the e-posters at their convenience.

Poster Session Schedule


- O There will be six designated time slots for the Poster session. Presenting authors will be notified by email regarding their assigned poster session.
- O As the number of e-Poster boards is limited, presenters are not required to stand by their poster during the assigned discussion time.

• Formatting:

- O Create your e-poster in portrait orientation with a size of Width 1080 * Height 1920 pixels.
- O Use high-quality images and graphics to enhance the clarity and visual impact of your e-poster.
- O Recommended font sizes: Title Arial 40; Author Arial 23; Affiliation Arial 23.



• Content and Language:

- O Use people-first language when describing individuals, emphasizing their identity over medical conditions or disabilities.
- O Ensure that your poster is clear and concise, focusing on the essentials of your research.
- O Include a clear and concise title that accurately reflects the content of your e-poster.
- O List all authors and their affiliations.
- O Clearly state the background, objectives, methods, results, and conclusion of your research.
- O Use charts, graphs, and other visual aids to present your results in a clear and concise manner.
- O Optional: Include a list of references used in your study and declare any conflicts of interest.

• Poster Submission:

O Please upload your poster in PPT/PDF format to the ACN presentation management portal by August 28th, 2023.

• Additional Information:

- O There is no need to bring printed posters unless you are selected for Best Poster Competition. If chosen as a candidate for the competition, you will receive a separate email notifying you to bring a printed poster for display.
- O Consider providing handouts or a digital version of your e-poster for interested viewers to take with them.
